In order to manage demand, lawn watering must be conducted on the even/odd lawn watering schedule.

Even numbered addresses - Sunday, Wednesday, Friday

Odd numbered addresses - Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday

No watering on Monday

Heavy rain continues to make nitrate concentrations fluctuate in the Raccoon and Des Moines Rivers. As nitrate concentrations decrease city, county, state, and school district irrigation will be phased in.
